Spinning the globe and finding out about different places is a great way to learn about different countries and cultures!

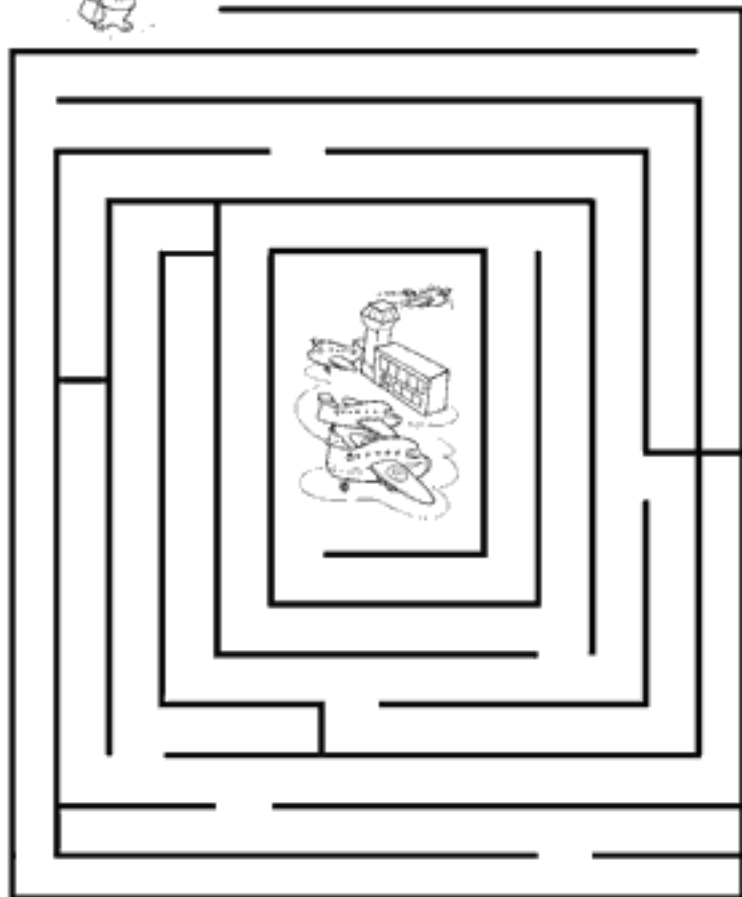
