I wonder who they are?**



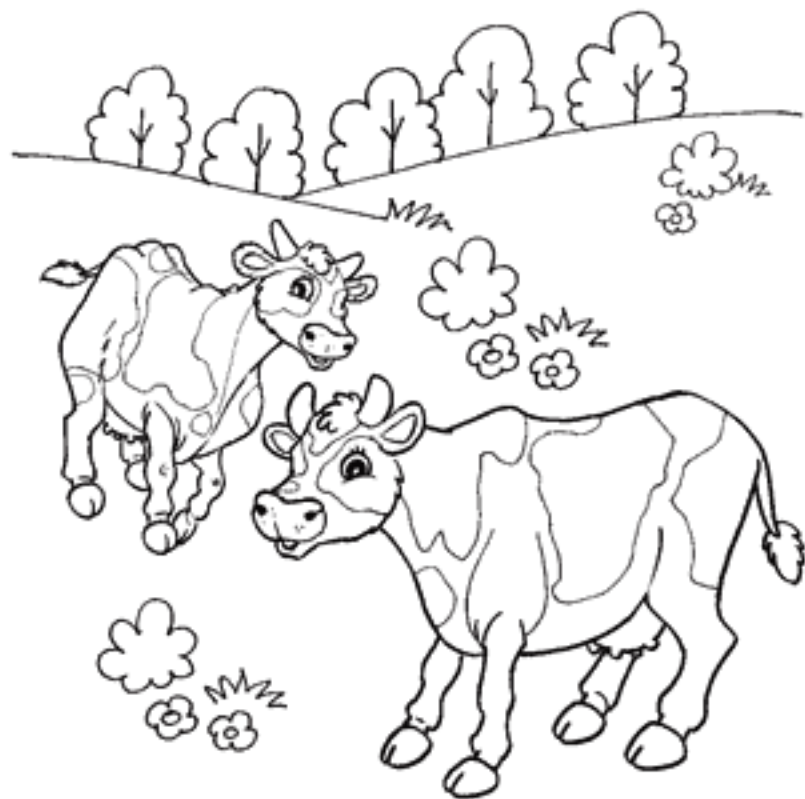
**The first friend I met was Uncle Charlie's dog, Mike.

**We walked to the barn. It was cool and smelled like hay.**

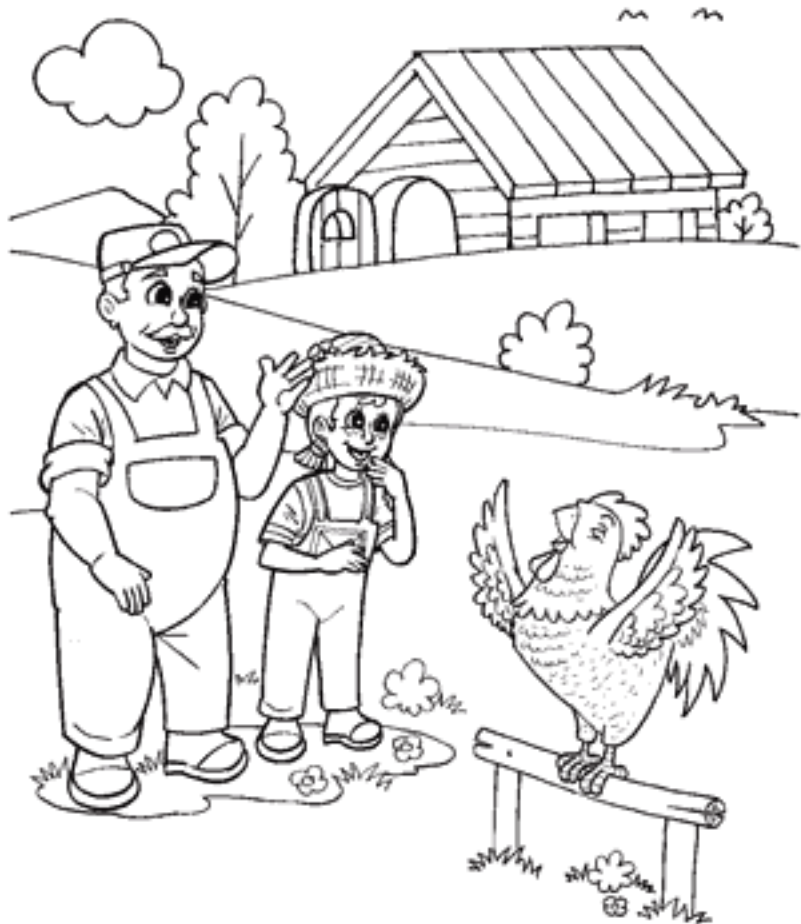


**I met Billy and Milly, Uncle Charlie's goats.

**The pigs were next. They live in their pen and have such cute curly tails. Then I met the horses, and even the cat who lives in the barn.**



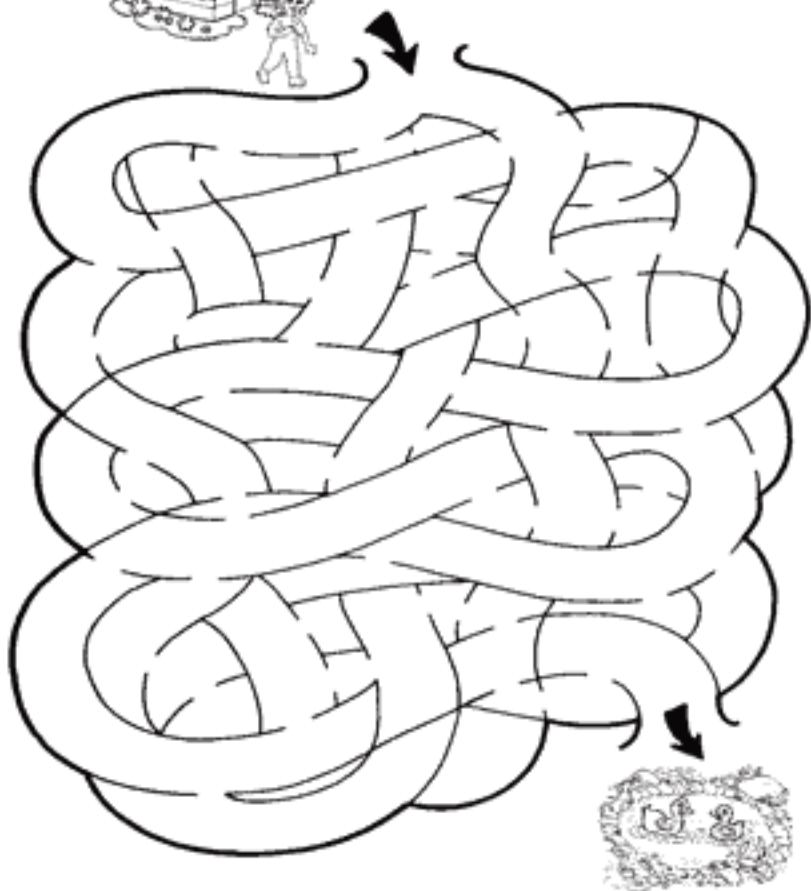


**"Wow," I told Uncle Charlie. "These animals are great. I never knew a farm could be so interesting."
